## Notes

- Learn to Skate (LTS) Program Communication
  - An email regarding the Learn to Skate program was sent to the club.
  - There was a general understanding among some members that all coaches were involved.
  - Not all of the coaches were ware of the circumstances around LTS and how it was started
- Awareness and Communication Within the Club
  - Discussion around who was informed about the Learn to Skate initiative.
  - Noted that the program had been potentially discussed previously in a January meeting as well as years prior. No consensus if these conversations took place.
- Club Capacity and Program Management
  - Some members expressed concern about whether the club has the capacity to successfully run a Learn to Skate program.
  - Others noted the program's scale and questioned whether it would be feasible for the club to take on.
- Ethics and Conflict of Interest
  - Discussion of ethical expectations for those serving under U.S. Figure Skating, including:
    - Avoiding personal gain.
    - Preventing institutional loss.
    - Emphasis on the importance of avoiding both actual conflicts of interest and the appearance of conflicts.
